**DATE:**

**SOCIAL SKILL OBJECTIVE:** Students will understand that positive peer relationships are built on trust. Once you are dishonest with someone, it is very hard to get them to trust you again.

**GAME:** Making Choices

**SOCIAL SKILLS EXPECTATIONS:** When discussing specific behaviors that impact relationships, ask: Who, What, Where, When, Why, and How in relation to behaviors.

**FOLLOW UP AT HOME:**

Discuss these things with your child.

- The importance of calling a parent after returning home from school.
- The importance of always telling the truth.
- The importance of having friends and family trust you.
